You have taken the first step to accessing the treatment room service. Our team consists of a number of professionals who are dedicated to providing high quality care to patients within the St. Helens borough.

The treatment room team have looked at your referral and you have been given an appointment to ensure that you are seen by the most appropriate health care professional for your condition.

Clinics are held across the borough and we have made every attempt to provide you with an appointment at a clinic near to where you live. However, attendance at some clinics may involve travelling to another location in the St. Helens area. Your appointment is enclosed with this leaflet.

The Treatment Room Service is provided for patients aged 18 and over, who are registered with a GP within the St. Helens borough. Patients can self-refer or go through their GP/local hospital.

The Treatment Room Service provides a clinical setting for wound care, removal of sutures (stitches, staples, and clips), injections, ear irrigation, Doppler assessment and catheter care.

Please note...

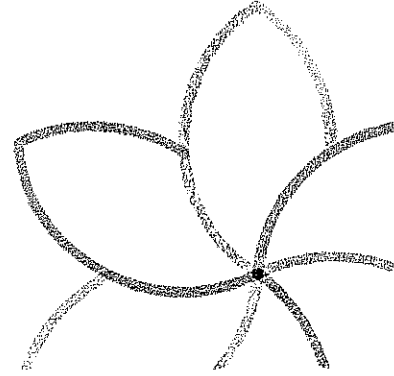
- * Patients are kindly asked to arrive at least 5 minutes prior to appointment time.
